→ Replacing inefficient light globes with energy-efficient light globes.

Contact a **participating business** providing replacement lighting services and ask for the Energy Saver Incentive – a discount or special offer.

Remember, the more greenhouse gas emissions you save, the bigger the potential incentive.

# Lighting your home efficiently. What you need to know.



## Energy Saver Action requirements.

**To be eligible for the Energy Saver Incentive for replacing inefficient light globes with energy-efficient light globes there are some requirements you or your participating business will need to meet.**

- Energy efficient lighting must replace inefficient lighting.
- All lighting products must be installed in residential homes.
- All lighting products must be professionally installed by **participating businesses**, including light globes and lamps. This is so the greenhouse gas savings can be properly calculated.
- Your supplier may offer a range of lighting products. Ask your **participating business** which of these products attracts the Energy Saver Incentive.
- You will be asked to sign a form which shows the incentive you received for your Energy Saving action.

## How Elenni sheds some light on saving energy.

- Elenni wants to reduce the energy she uses to light her home. She has heard about Compact Fluorescent Lights (CFLs) and wants to save energy by replacing her old fashioned light bulbs. Her current lights are just too expensive to run, not to mention the additional heat they create.
- When she finds a flyer in her letterbox from a sustainable solutions company that mentions the Energy Saver Incentive, Elenni thinks now is the time to make the change.
- She contacts the company and confirms they are participating in the Energy Saver Incentive. After making an appointment, a company representative comes over and offers Elenni free energy-efficient Compact Fluorescent Lights, as an Energy Saver Incentive.
- Elenni agrees and the company representative installs the energy efficient lighting on the spot.
- After the new lights have been installed, Elenni signs a form confirming the incentive she has received – her free Compact Fluorescent Lights.
- The company representative provides Elenni with a brochure that lists other Energy Saving actions, such as showerheads, a solar hot water system and energy efficient heating for Elenni to consider.
- She's got free new lights and made a time to get new water-saving showerheads fitted in both her bathrooms. Her future energy bills will decrease. And she's helping Victoria reach its energy saving target of 2.7 million tonnes of greenhouse gas per year.
