Contact a **participating business** fitting water-saving shower heads and ask about the Energy Saver Incentive – a discount or special offer.

Remember, the more greenhouse gas emissions you save, the bigger the potential incentive.

Installing a water-saving shower head. What you need to know.

Energy Saver Action requirements.

To be eligible for the Energy Saver Incentive on water-saving shower heads there are some requirements you or your participating business will need to meet.

- Water-saving shower heads must replace conventional shower heads.
- Shower heads must be installed in residential homes.
- Water saving shower-heads must be professionally installed by **participating businesses**. This is so the greenhouse gas savings can be properly calculated.
- Your supplier may offer preferred shower head products. Ask your **participating businesses** which approved products they can supply.
- You will be asked to sign a form which shows the incentive you received for your energy saving action.

For more details about the requirements ask your participating business before you buy.

How Danny cleans up on a new shower head.

- Danny knows his old shower heads in both his bathrooms are sending an unnecessary amount of water, and money, down the drain so when he receives a letter in the mail from a **participating business** about the Energy Saver Incentive he decides this is a good time to act.
- The letter he receives in the mail provides detail on a number of energy saving actions available under the Energy Saver Incentive, including an energy-efficient shower head, one with a rating of three stars or higher.
- Danny knows, the more greenhouse gas saved, the bigger the potential discount or special offer so he responds to the **participating business** and seeks an Energy Saver Incentive on the shower head with the highest star rating.
- The business arranges a time for someone to visit Danny's place to install his new water-saving shower heads. The installer takes the old ones with him to be decommissioned. Before he leaves he asks Danny to sign a form to confirm his incentive – the new water-saving shower heads.
- Danny has now got his new water-saving shower-head installed for free. His future energy bills will decrease. And he is helping Victoria reach its energy saving target of 2.7 million tonnes of greenhouse gas per year.
